SHUTTLE SERVICE

SATURDAY MORNING SHUTTLES

- Complimentary shuttle service will be offered from the Fess Park to Chase Palm Park (the Opening Ceremony site) on Saturday, September 9, 2017.
- Walker & Crew shuttles will begin running at 3:30 am.
- The last shuttle will depart from the hotel by 6:00 am.
- **We strongly recommend you take an early shuttle to ensure you arrive in time for the Opening Ceremony, which will begin at 6:30 am.**

SUNDAY AFTERNOON SHUTTLES

- Complimentary shuttles will leave from Carpinteria State Beach to return to The Fess Parker starting after the Closing Ceremony has concluded.

ADDITIONAL WEEKEND SHUTTLES

For those who choose not to camp with us and leave the event for the night, Non-Camping shuttle services will be offered throughout the weekend on the following schedule:

Non-Camping Shuttles* - Saturday Evening

- Shuttles will leave Basecamp 39 to return to The Fess Parker beginning at 2:00 pm with the last departure leaving at 8:00 pm for those participants who choose to leave the event for the night.

Non-Camping Shuttles* - Sunday Morning

- Shuttles will pick up non-campers from The Fess Parker to return to Basecamp 39 in time for the route opening.
- Shuttles begin at 5:00 am with the last departure leaving at 6:30 am.

***A Non-Camping Shuttle wristband will be required to utilize either of these extra shuttles.** Wristbands can be purchased at Check-In Friday and Basecamp 39 on Saturday for **\$20** (credit card or personal check only – no cash please). Bus wristbands will NOT be sold on Sunday morning. Wristbands are non-refundable and for registered participants only. Shuttles will begin leaving Basecamp 39 on Saturday afternoon at **4:00 pm**.

The Fess Parker is accessible via public transportation with the use of local buses.

MTD:

AMTRAK:

The Fess Parker is a 1 mile walk from the Amtrak Station in downtown Santa Barbara.

TAXI:

Taxis are available from Santa Barbara Airport. Cost may vary depending on the taxi company.

PARKING:

Parking is available at the Check In entrance of the Fess Parker.

- Parking rates are as follows:
 - **Valet:** Standard Size Automobiles/SUV: \$26.00 for 24 hours
 - **Self-Parking for those that are hotel guests and participants :** \$10.00 per 24 hours
 - **Self-Parking for hotel participants:** \$20.00 per 24 hours

Note: parking is free on Friday for those attending Check-In Friday

FOR PARTICIPANT PARKING:

Overnight parking: [1 Garden Street Lot](#) is \$24 all day (located across just across Cabrillo Blvd from ceremony site)
Day Parking: Palm Lot (located directly west of ceremony site) is \$2 per hour for a maximum of \$12 total. There is NO parking in this lot between 2am-6am

Please note: Overnight parking is only available at The Fess Parker and The Garden Street Lot
