SHUTTLE SERVICE

SATURDAY MORNING SHUTTLES

Complimentary shuttle service will be offered from The Fess Parker Doubletree Resort to the Opening Ceremony site on Saturday, September 12, 2015. Walker shuttles will begin running at 4:30 am. ***The last shuttle will depart from the hotel by 6:00 am.***

We strongly recommend you take an early shuttle to ensure you arrive in time for the Opening Ceremony, which will begin at 6:30 am.

SUNDAY AFTERNOON SHUTTLES

Complimentary shuttles will leave from Carpinteria State Beach Park and return to The Fess Parker Doubletree Resort and the overnight parking lot immediately following the Closing Ceremony.

ADDITIONAL WEEKEND SHUTTLES

For those who choose not to camp with us and leave the event for the night, Non-Camping shuttle services will be offered throughout the weekend on the following schedule:

Non-Camping Shuttles* - Saturday Evening

Shuttles will leave Basecamp 39 to return to The Fess Parker Doubletree Resort and the overnight parking lot beginning at 4:00 pm with the last departure leaving at 8:00 pm for those participants who choose to leave the event for the night.

Non-Camping Shuttles* - Sunday Morning

Shuttles will pick up non-campers from The Fess Parker Doubletree Resort and the overnight parking lot to return to Basecamp 39 in time for the route opening. Buses begin at 5:00 am with the ***last departure leaving at 6:30 am.***

** A Non-Camping Shuttle wristband will be required to utilize either of these extra shuttles. Wristbands can be purchased at Check-In Friday and Basecamp 39 on Saturday for \$20 (credit card or personal check only – no cash please). Bus wristbands will NOT be sold on Sunday morning. Wristbands are non-refundable and for registered participants only. Shuttles will begin leaving Basecamp 39 on Saturday afternoon at 4:00 pm.*

Advance Shuttle Bus Wristband Purchases will be available online until Thursday, September 10, 2015 at 4:00 PM ET. After this time, you will only be able to purchase your shuttle bus wristband in person at Check-In Friday or at the Shuttle Bus area at Basecamp 39. From the East:

- Take I-5 South

- Turn right onto North Calle Cesar Chavez

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

The Fess Parker Doubletree Resort is easily accessible by public transportation. There is a city bus stop at Cabrillo Boulevard and South Calle Cesar Chavez. For information regarding the city bus stops, contact 805-963-3366 or visit www.sbmttd.gov. Also, Santa Barbara has an Amtrak Station that is located at East Yanonali and State Street, less than a mile from the hotel. If you are a guest of the hotel you may call (805) 564-4333 ahead of time to arrange for a free shuttle to pick you up. For information regarding Amtrak services, visit www.amtrak.com.

PARKING:

Complimentary free parking is available at The Fess Parker Doubletree Resort for Check-In Friday. If you are a guest staying overnight at the hotel, self parking is \$10 per night.

Cars parked overnight in non-AVON 39 public lots will be subject to citation.

- Take Highway US-101 South

- Left onto Carpinteria Ave.
- Right onto Palm Ave., following signs for State Park
- Palm Ave. will end at parking lot for Carpinteria State Beach. Additional parking can be found on city streets.
